






Private/Independent **Colleges** and Universities

Key Terms

Early Decision:

- You are applying to the earlier deadline
- You may apply to only one college under early decision
- If accepted, you are committed to that school
- Withdraw you other applications
- Early decision deadlines are often in November
- Students are typically notified of the decision in December

Early Action:

- You are applying to the earlier deadline
- You may apply to multiple college under early action
- Nonbinding, you are able to see other commitments
- Do not have to commit until April 30th
- Early action deadlines are often in November
- Students are typically notified of the decision in December



Personal Essay

Some colleges require submission of the personal essay with your Common Application. You may submit a personal essay to any college, even if it is not required by that college. If not required by a college, you will be given the option during submission to include your essay or not for that college.*



Here is the current list of colleges on your Dashboard and whether they require the Personal Essay.

Not Required

The essay demonstrates your ability to write clearly and concisely on a selected topic and helps you distinguish yourself in your own voice. What do you want the readers of your application to know about you apart from courses, grades, and test scores? Choose the option that best helps you answer that question and write an essay of no more than 650 words, using the prompt to inspire and structure your response. Remember: 650 words is your limit, not your goal. Use the full range if you need it, but don't feel obligated to do so. (The application won't accept a response shorter than 250

- Some students have a background, identity, interest, or talent that is so meaningful they believe their application would be incomplete without it. If this sounds like you, then please share your story.
- The lessons we take from obstacles we encounter can be fundamental to later success. Recount a time when you faced a challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience?
- Reflect on a time when you questioned or challenged a belief or idea. What prompted your thinking? What was the outcome?
- Describe a problem you've solved or a problem you'd like to solve. It can be an intellectual challenge, a research query, an ethical dilemma-anything that is of personal importance, no matter the scale. Explain its significance to you and what steps you took or could be taken to identify a solution.
- Discuss an accomplishment, event, or realization that sparked a period of personal growth and a new understanding of yourself or others.
- Describe a topic, idea, or concept you find so engaging that it makes you lose all track of time. Why does it captivate you? What or who do you turn to when you want to learn more?
- Share an essay on any topic of your choice. It can be one you've already written, one that responds to a different prompt, or one of your own design.





- Better alumni-networks and resources for obtaining jobs, internships & other opportunities
- Smaller student body and class sizes
 - More likely to get into required classes and graduate in 4 years
- Many guarantee on campus housing all 4 years
